OUR APPROACH

DISCOVERY CALL

All new projects begin with a 30-minute phone call between the designer and the potential client.

The call should focus on:

- Design challenges and overview of the SOW (scope of work)
- The expectations of working with an Interior Designer
- Mood and style
- Project timeline and budget

FOLLOWING THE DISCOVERY CALL WE SCHEDULE A 1 TO 2-HOUR SITE VISIT (\$250).

In this meeting, while we walk through the space I will take detailed notes and photos. From there, dive deeper into style preferences such as color, space layout, and existing elements that should be incorporated into the new design.

INITIAL PROPOSAL

We are a flat fee-based company. This way, we keep a simplified invoicing system, and that are no surprises. Our clients know exactly what to expect as their project's total investment cost. Everything is discussed upfront, and we do not charge additional design fees afterward.

Upon moving forward, you receive a proposal with our full estimated design fee based on your the project's size, scope, and timeline. Once the proposal is approved, our office sends the official contract and an invoice of 50% of the estimated fees to be completed prior to the project's kick-off.

- Purchases, Vendors, and Deliveries
- Project Coordination and Site Overseen

PHASE FOUR

- Complete Installation
- Styling and Professional Photos
- Final Walkthrough

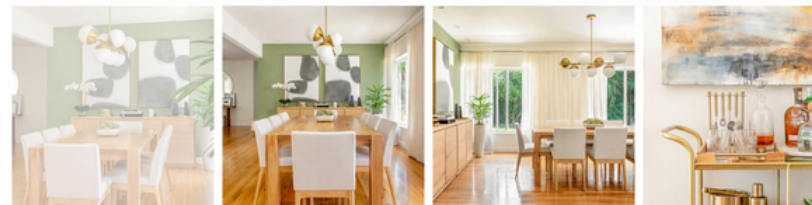
